There's inspiration at every angle at **Eltham Palace**. This groundbreaking house combines medieval remains with masterful art deco design– including Marion Dorn's circular rug, which took pride of place in the grand entrance hall.

This extensive range features three pendants, a flush ceiling light, wall light and table lamp. Two of the pendants digress stylistically through the use of crystal rods as opposed to crystal swags; a nuance that was





partly inspired by the stunning hammer beam roof seen in the great hall building and brings yet another dimension to the range.

The use of polished nickel metalwork coupled with subtle yet stylish surface flourishes serves as a counterpoint to the crystal.

This opulent collection is reflective of a property that is itself steeped in rich design and cultural history.









Our designers used spectacular curved crystal to create these Art Deco designs. A sensitively detailed rim finished in polished nickel completes this design.



This elegant range is inspired by the grand chandeliers in the drawing room of **Osborne**, Queen Victoria and Prince Albert's beloved seaside home. The flush chandelier and traditional hanging chandelier add a touch of opulence to any home, no matter what the style.





Through use of a combination of aesthetically stepped tiers, as well as a mixture of coffin, tear drop and bead shaped faceted crystal embellishments, these pieces are multifaceted, intricate and beautiful when lit.

Our designers have used traditional faceted crystal to great effect in creating these opulent lighting fixtures. The flush fitting allows this to be experienced even where ceiling heights are limited.

When creating a truly luxurious chandelier, our designer drew inspiration from the delicately carved and gilded state bed in the Howard Suite of **Audley End House**.

This range consists of three designs: a grand six-light chandelier, a miniaturised three-light chandelier and a beautiful five-light flush. Each design is finished in hand-applied gold leaf and decorative cut crystal weaves through the intricate branches of each design.

In stark contrast, for a more functional design destined for a country kitchen, our designers took cues from the utilitarian lighting found in the working Victorian kitchen.





This range has a beautifully simple elegance. It consists of a two-light semi-flush pendant, a single pendant and a wall light, all with authentic detailing.

Built on the site of an abbey in the early 17th century, **Audley End** was the most ambitious house of its time. Its scale was reduced over time, but it was reinvigorated in the Jacobean style in the 19th century under the 3rd Baron Braybrooke.



The Wrest Park collection features delicately hand-blown ribbed glass on an elegant aged brass frame, reflecting on the designs of early Venetian chandeliers.

This chandelier and matching wall lamp are inspired by the interiors of the remarkable Wrest Park, a 19th century-English house in the style of an 18th-century French chateau.

In a response to the elaborately constructed chandeliers found within the large hosting rooms inside the property, these two fittings combine clear decorative glass and gently undulating arms to create a grandiose and sophisticated finished form that would not look out of place in a traditional or more contemporary setting.

Marble Hill inspired our designers to create a range of Georgian lighting suitable for the modern home. Built in the 1720s for Henrietta Howard, **Marble Hill** was an idyllic Thames-side retreat from court life.

In 1755 the house's dining room was adorned with fashionable hand-painted chinoiserie wallpaper. It took workers 47 days to hang 62 sheets of the paper.



The patterns in this collection draw reference from various properties as well as the archival pattern development work done by Designers Guild. These designs have been reimagined into individual lampshades and shade linings for a stylish and co-ordinated range.


Down House is the home of the great scientist Charles Darwin (1809–82), who lived here for 40 years. These designs incorporate our take on the blue sprigged wallpaper found in the drawing room.





This collection comprises four multi arm pendants finished in satin chrome and antique brass that showcase the archive design beautifully, each paired with a complementing linen outer fabric. Alongside these there are also four flush ceiling lights in matching colour ways, three pleated shades in two colour ways, and two drum shades in a matching colour way.









Arts & Crafts style fabric inspired by **Down House** lines this beautiful shadelier and flush ceiling light. Both are supplied with an attractive navy slubbed outer.




